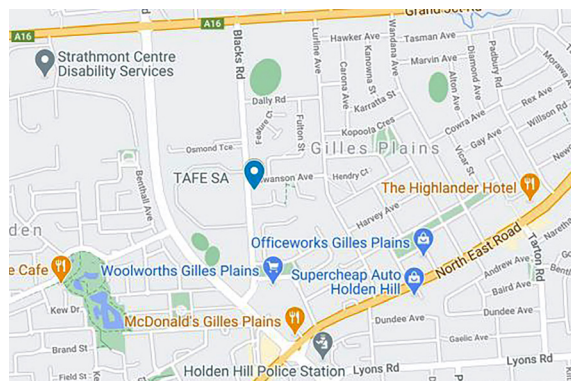
Wandana creates connections

Wandana Community Garden

We always welcome new participants at our garden, which provides a space for community members to interact, connect with nature and with each other.

Our garden has shared plots (not individual allotments) and produce is distributed amongst the gardeners and the Community Centre's kitchen.

We gather and garden on Mondays during school terms only, from 9am to 12pm.

Visitors and new members are welcome to join at any time. This is a free service and no experience is required.

Playgroups

Our playgroups run weekly during the school term and focus on child and parent wellbeing, learning and development.

Playgroups are an opportunity for children to learn and develop skills for school, and provide parents with opportunity to connect with other parents, socialise and share experiences of parenting.
