## Whyalla Homelessness Service

The Whyalla Homelessness Service provides access to crisis, supportive, and transitional accommodation with individualised in-centre and outreach case management support for persons referred or self-presenting, who are experiencing or are at risk of homelessness.

### Services

We provide a range of services to independent persons aged 15 and over who are homeless or at risk of homelessness.

- Confidential intake
- Risk and needs assessment
- Referral to specialised housing programs
- Client centered, trauma informed case management
- Referral to housing providers / options
- Advocacy
- Information and referral to other required services
- Advice

### Eligibility

This service is available to all people aged 15 years and over who are experiencing or at risk of homelessness.

### Cost

There is no fee for service, however, payment of rent is required for the Crisis Housing Program, Transitional Housing Program and Supportive Housing Program.

### Referrals

- Referrals are accepted via phone or presentation to office from individuals, families and other service providers
- The service operates 9am to 5pm Monday to Friday (except for Public Holidays).
