

Lawyer Inclusive Practice

A voluntary process where parties work towards an outcome with respect to their parenting or property matters with the assistance of a Family Dispute Resolution Practitioner (FDRP) and parties' legal practitioners.



Parties undergo the same process as Family Dispute Resolution (mediation) with the added Lawyer Inclusive component. Refer to the flowcharts on the following page for an overview.

HOW: Parties can self-refer. Referrals are also received from the courts and legal professionals





Parties can self-refer by contacting our office to schedule an intake appointment. Legal practitioners can refer clients by completing a referral form, our Family Advisor will then contact the parties to initiate the process.

Additionally, we may refer parties to seek legal advice and to consider engaging a legal representative of their choice to participate in Lawyer Inclusive Practice.

FEE FOR SERVICE

SAFETY

Centacare takes the safety of families very seriously. If you have any safety concerns, please discuss them with your FDRP.

CONFIDENTIALITY

Confidentiality and privacy are of the utmost importance in FDR services. All FDRPs and Child Consultants must work within the Family Law Act (FLA) 1975 – Section 10H, where communications made in FDR are not able to be disclosed and are inadmissible in court unless required or authorised under the FLA.

FDRPs are required to disclose information to appropriate authorities where suspicions of safety to a person or property are revealed. Under section 67ZA, information disclosed indicating reasonable grounds of suspicion that a child has been or is at risk of being abused must also be reported.
