## What is Carlow Place?

---

Carlow Place is a 24-hour supported accommodation core and cluster residential facility located in the Elizabeth area.

The service provides emergency and medium to long-term accommodation for young people aged 15-17 years who are homeless or are at risk of becoming homeless.

We wrap service provision around each client to provide a specialised individual support plan from an Adolescent Specialist Case Manager and Youth Support Workers.

Carlow Place aims to provide each young person with a daily routine for life and a safe place to call home.

## Services

---

- 24/7 on-site supported accommodation, with support provided to promote young people's independent living skills, health, well-being, social and educational connections
- Case management, information, advocacy and referral.

## Eligibility

---

- Young people aged 15-17 years who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless
- Be receiving or awaiting approval of an independent income e.g.: Independent Youth Allowance, Special Benefit, etc.

Referrals for young people under 14 years need to be made to the Department for Child Protection, and for people over 17 years, to Homelessness Connect or the Youth Services Team.
