Statement regarding the traditional owners of the land



Youth Services Barossa

Youth Services Barossa provides the Outer North Youth Homelessness Service to young people aged 15-25 years who are homeless or are at risk of becoming homeless.

Case Managers work in a collaborative approach with community-based services within the Barossa Council region.

Services

- Supported Tenancies and Supportive
 Housing are generally allocated to young
 people aged over 18 who are homeless,
 who are at risk of becoming homeless,
 or whom face other barriers in accessing
 alternative forms of accommodation
- Clients are allocated a case manager to provide supports, specifically around developing independent living skills, which includes health and education, and connections with community services
- Case management, support, information, advocacy and referral
- Some capacity to provide support to eligible clients living in private rental and SA Housing Authority properties.

Eligibility

- Young people aged 15-25 years who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless, or whom face significant barriers in accessing accommodation
- Be receiving or awaiting approval of an independent income.

Referrals for young people under 14 years need to be made to the Department for Child Protection.
